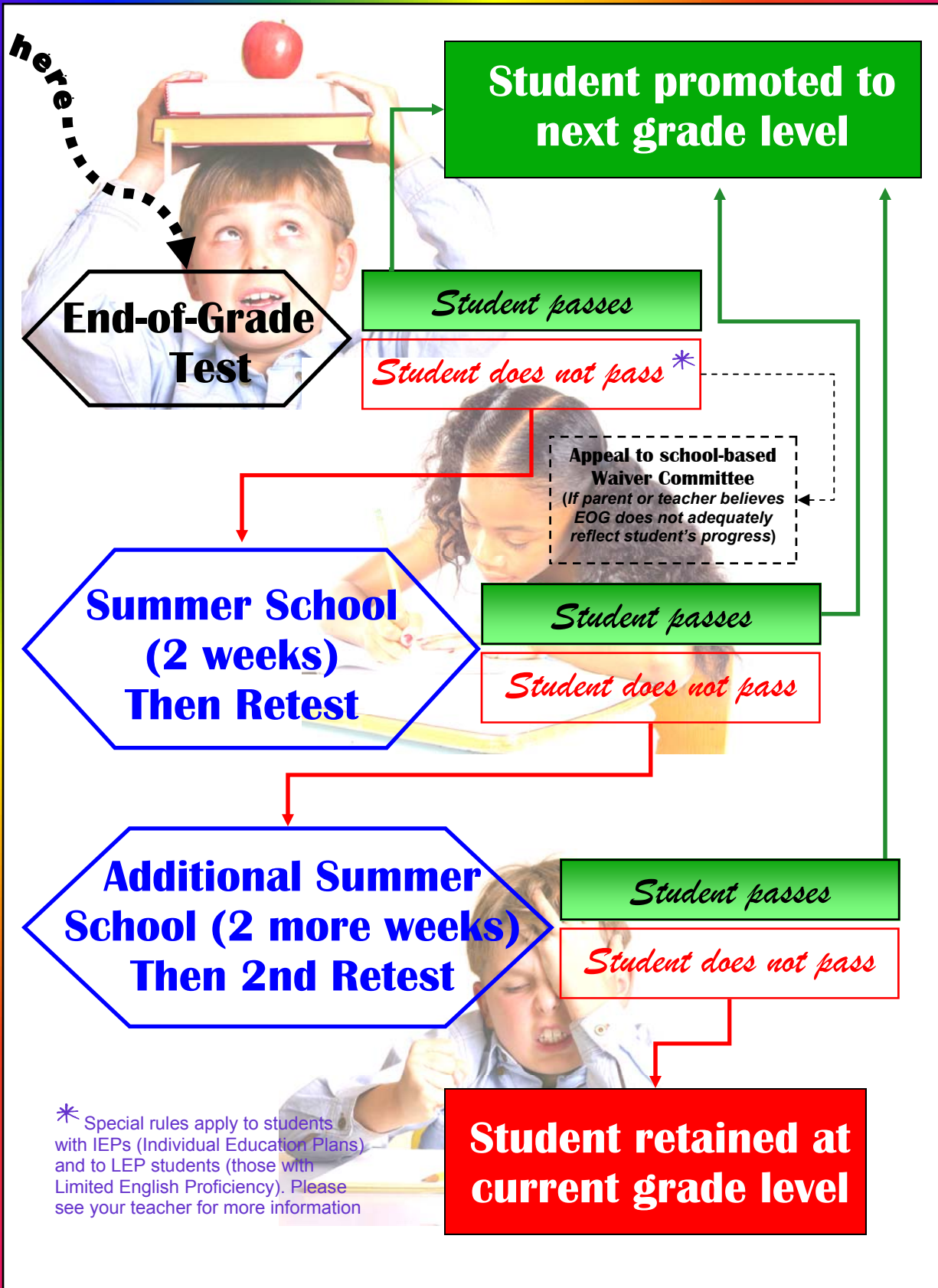


Students who do not pass the second retest will be retained at their current grade level. A student must be academically ready for the next level to be promoted.

step-by-step

All students in grades 3-8 must pass a state "End-of-Grade" (EOG) test to be promoted to the next grade.

Students who do not pass the EOG must attend summer school. A retest will be given after two weeks of summer school. Students who pass will be promoted. Those who do not pass will continue in summer school for two more weeks. A second retest will be given at the end of summer school.
