**Joint Meeting BOE/BOCC:** This past Tuesday evening, the Board of Education and the Board of County Commissioners met to discuss several important issues. First, the BOCC made a commitment to complete all projects outlined in the 2004 bond. Second, with a unanimous vote, the BOCC directed the Board of Education to complete the construction projects at Bunn and Louisburg High Schools. They encouraged our board to purchase land for a high school and an elementary school. Once land is purchased, they suggested that we complete the design of the new high school. Lastly, the BOCC did not act on the BOE resolution to conduct a bond referendum in November.

**NCWISE:** As we approach the end of the 2005-2006 school year, we realize how far we have come with NCWISE and how much we have learned. We still have a ways to go, but we are looking forward to working with old and new staff to enhance the use of NCWISE in the areas of attendance, progress reports, grade books and data for special programs like our EC, LEP and homeless. Right now, some of this data has to be kept in separate programs and also in NCWISE. This causes a lot of duplicate data entry work. Terri Wynne has done an outstanding job with our EC students in reaching 100% accuracy with EC student information in matching CECAS and NCWISE data and has also set a standard for other systems to duplicate.
