



Students with Food Allergies

Policy Code: 4225

The Franklin County Board of Education recognizes the increasing frequency and intensity of allergic reactions to foods by certain students and the impact these reactions may have on all children in the educational environment. Therefore Franklin County Schools will:

- Make every reasonable effort to promote and protect the health of children in school by providing food choices that are safe as well as nutritious;
- Provide environments that reduce the risk of ingestion or contact with foods that trigger allergic reactions for students with known life-threatening food allergies;
- Provide prevention and management educational materials to staff, parents and students.

The Superintendent will adopt an administrative regulation setting forth a detailed plan for how the district will accomplish the above objectives that shall include information regarding the development of appropriate accommodations or healthcare plans for individual students with life-threatening allergies to food.
