



US and NC FLAGS, PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Policy Code: 3100

NC General Statute 115C-47 (29a) requires the display of the United States and North Carolina flags and requires the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance in all NC classrooms. Thus, Franklin County Schools will require each classroom to display the United States and North Carolina flags, when available, and recite the Pledge of Allegiance on a daily basis. Elementary classroom teachers and middle and high school social studies teachers who teach United States History, Civics or North Carolina History will provide instruction on the meaning and historical origins of the flags and the Pledge of Allegiance. The school shall not compel any person to stand, salute the flag, or recite the Pledge of Allegiance.
