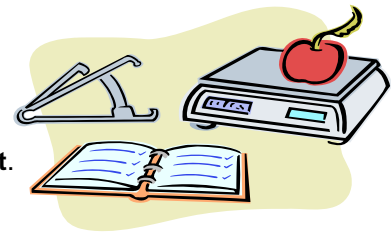

- Automated notification, via e-mail, when your child's account balance falls below an amount you have set.
- **\$10 one-time fee, no longer an annual fee. Parents who registered during school year 2010-2011 will not need to pay again.**

To register and make a payment on your child's account go to <https://www.lunchprepay.com/Redirection.aspx>. You will need your child's Student ID, which can be obtained by calling the Child Nutrition Office at 919-496-5125. (Note: This is NOT your child's serving number that is used to purchase meals.) Registration is usually automatic, but it may take up to 24 hours for your student to be verified. Once payment is made, it should show on your child's account within 24 hours.
